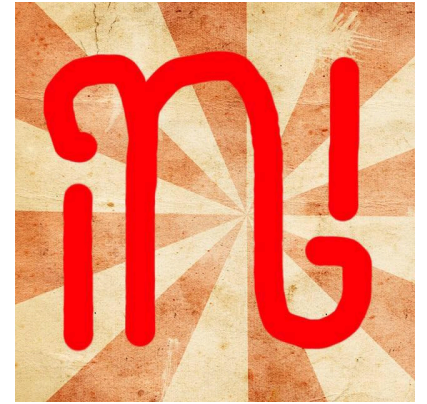

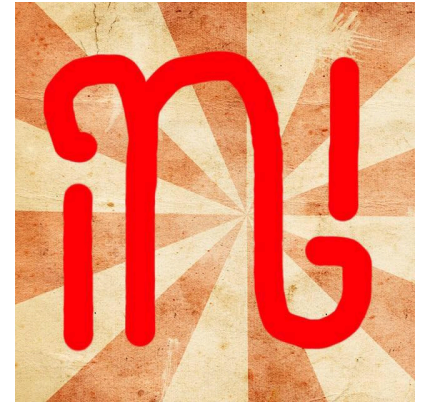

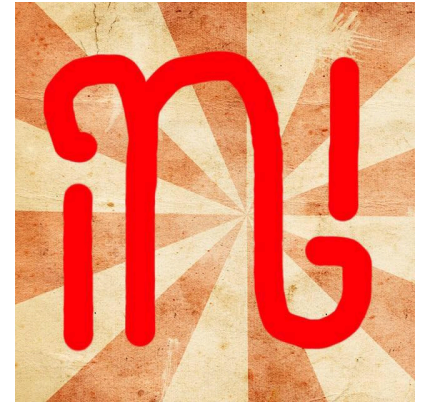

Ben has been making music since the 1980s, first as a bass player, later as vocalist and guitarist.

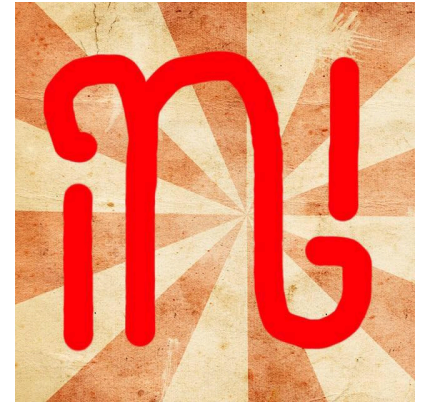
While based in Switzerland, he performed as the lead singer in different bands, and he started to write and record more songs, both in rock.

After which, his playing became more influenced by top 40s and post-rock songs.

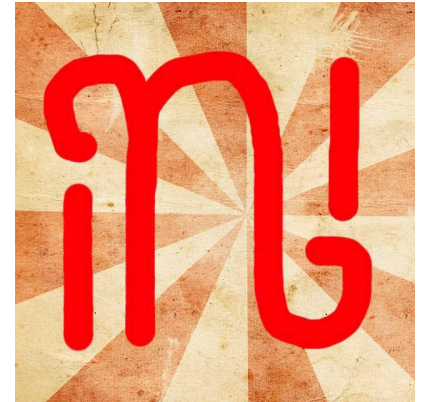
Studied Diploma in Music and Audio Technology at Singapore Polytechnic, he has been involved with our national music festival, Bay Beats, held annually at the Esplanade.

She picked up the bass at 18 and won gold at the Singapore Youth Festival in 2004 and 2006.

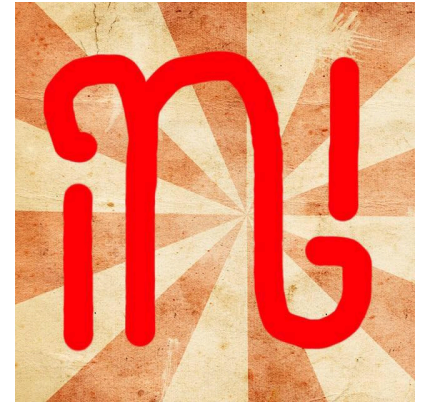
She is influenced by bands such as Incognito and Jamiroquai. As time passes, she incorporates different genres such as pop, RnB and funk into her music.

Profile Ben Hoe

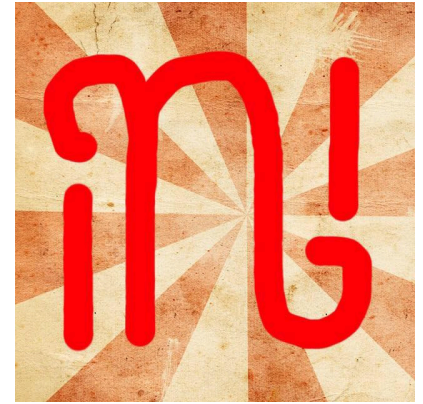


Ben started playing drums in his teens.

Eileen Chai is the violinist in the band.

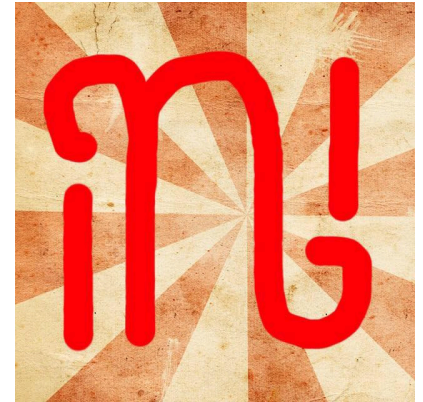
She is a recipient of the Nanyang Outstanding Young Alumni Award, and is on the Singapore Olympic Academy Roll of Honour,

She is a former gymnast, hurdler, and springboard diver. She first represented Singapore at age 7, youngest in history of the SEA Games and she won a Bronze Medal at the SEA Games at 13. At 15, she broke the National Age-Group 100m Hurdles Record; at 16, she won gold at the Asia Pacific Diving Competition; and at 27, she broke the National 100m Hurdles Record.

Today, Eileen is the first local violinist to compose and perform original songs by live looping on the violin, with vocals.

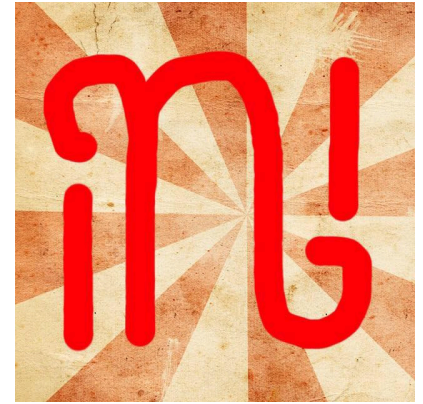
Through the years, she has performed at a number of key events – 107th International Olympic Council Session, Commonwealth Queen's Baton Relay, 40th Ship for Southeast Asian Youth Programme, Young Women's Leadership Connection's International Women's Day.

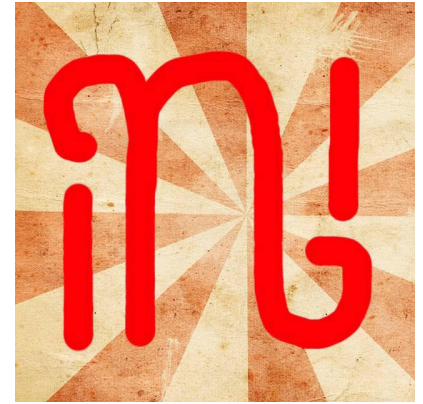

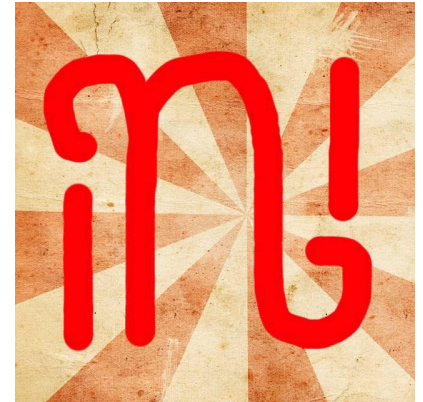
She has also played for the National University of Singapore Symphony Orchestra, and the Singapore Youth Orchestra.
